



TRAIL INFORMATION

General	Steady climb of 335 metres (1100 feet) through mixed Acadian forest to a mountain summit with 360 degree views of the entire Clyburn Brook canyon and the Atlantic coastline from Cape Smokey to Ingonish. From the summit on a clear day it is possible to see White Hill, the highest elevation in the park (532 m / 1747 feet) and Money Point, the northern most tip of Cape Breton Island.
